Weinberg Center to Unveil Panel on the Theater’s History of Segregation

The Weinberg Center for the Arts will unveil a new interpretive panel documenting the history of segregation at the theater on Friday, October 2, 2026, at 11 a.m.

The unveiling will take place at the Weinberg Center, located at 20 W. Patrick St., Frederick, MD 21701. The mezzanine holds the last physical remnants of the bathrooms once designated for Black patrons during segregation, including holes in the marble where fixtures were attached.

The panel gives visitors historical context about the theater’s segregated past. In an era when the building was known as the Tivoli Theatre, Black patrons were separated from white audiences and required to use separate facilities. The project is meant to make sure this history is not overlooked, but is acknowledged as part of the full story of one of Frederick’s most prominent cultural landmarks.

The unveiling will take place on the eve of the Weinberg Center’s 100th anniversary season, a milestone in the theater’s history and its growth as a community arts institution.

For many members of Frederick’s Black community, memories and stories of that time period remain. The research behind the panel is an effort toward transparency and a fuller understanding of what those who lived through segregation in Frederick experienced.

It reflects the City’s commitment to transparency, integrity, and honoring all members of our community, including those who were excluded in the past.

Media and community members are invited to attend the unveiling and learn more about the history documented in the new panel.

Overnight Ramp Closures on Northbound US 15 for Pipe Inspections

The City of Frederick is notifying residents and motorists of upcoming overnight ramp closures on northbound US 15, as announced by the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration. These closures are necessary to conduct pipe inspections as part of the ongoing US 15 Capacity Improvement Project, which continues to progress through its design phase.

On Monday, September 14, the ramp to Rosemont Avenue (Exit 14) will be closed overnight from 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM the following morning. Motorists will be directed on a detour via 7th Street at Exit 15 and southbound US 15 to access Rosemont Avenue.

The northbound US 15 ramp to 7th Street at Exit 15 will be closed overnight on Tuesday, September 22. The detour for this closure will guide drivers to Motter Avenue at Exit 16, using southbound US 15 to reach 7th Street. Please note that all work is subject to weather conditions.

Additional pipe inspections will require single-lane and shoulder closures during overnight hours. The work is anticipated to be completed by October, weather permitting. For more information and updates on the US 15 capacity and road improvement project, please visit [here](#).

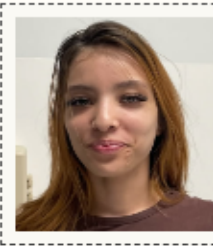
