The Frederick Police Department will conduct an Administrative Hearing Board on Sept. 30, 2026, in accordance with Maryland law. Administrative hearings are held at the request of a police officer who exercises their right to contest an internal affairs investigation and/or the findings of the Administrative Charging Committee of Frederick County. The proceedings will be accessible to the public. However, portions of the proceedings may be conducted in closed session, consistent with Maryland Public Safety Article § 3-106(e) and/or Maryland General Provisions § 3-305(b).

The proceedings will be viewable in the Community Room at Frederick Police Department headquarters, located on the first floor. Proceedings will begin at 8 a.m. on Sept. 30. Doors open at 7:30 a.m., and seating will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Individuals attending or viewing the Administrative Hearing Board will not be permitted to make audio or video recordings of any portion of the proceedings. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in removal from the viewing area. Anyone needing special accommodations must contact Professional Services Division Commander Lt. Matt Carrado at 301-600-2118 at least seven days in advance.

Health Department looking to contact owner of a dog

What you need to know: The Frederick County Health Department is asking for the public’s help to find a dog. What happened? The victim was scratched by a dog during a brief conversation with the owner of the dog on September 19, 2026, at around 5:00pm near the Park at Walnut Ridge Apartments off Tuscanney Drive in Frederick, MD. The dog, which was light brown in color and medium in size, was with its owner. The dog may be called “Lyle” by the owner. What you should do: If you have information about this animal, call Frederick County Animal Control at 301-600-1544.

What happens next? Once the owner is contacted, the animal will need to be verified to be in good health by Animal Control 10 days after the incident date. Then, the animal may resume normal activity, and the person who was bitten will not need to get expensive rabies treatment. If the owner is not contacted, the victim will be advised to get treatment. General Actions to Take: If a person or pet is bitten or scratched by an animal: Get the owner’s name, address, and phone number, then call Animal Control at 301-600-1544. If the animal is wildlife, consult your pet’s veterinarian (if applicable) and call Environmental Health Services at 301-600-1717.
